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
**Purpose:** To assure that the PIHP and affiliates of Community Mental Health of Mid Michigan (CMHAMM) have common policies and procedures concerning the assessment and service provision for individuals with co-occurring mental health and substance use disorders that are consistent with the standards set by the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH).

**Announcement:** CMHAMM Procedure 2.6, related to CMHAMM Policy 2.0, has been formally approved by the CMHAMM Director of Affiliation Operations (DAO). This procedure was developed with input from CMHAMM committees, councils, and/or workgroup(s) responsible for reviewing the affiliation activities addressed in the procedure. It will be reviewed by the DAO on an annual basis (minimally) and recommended revisions will be considered by the DAO during an announced review period. If appropriate, the DAO will formally rescind the previous version of the procedure and issue a revised version, based on affiliate recommendations and/or contractual obligations between the PIHP and MDCH or the PIHP and affiliate members.

The PIHP will only consider as valid, revisions to this procedure that have been communicated via the DAO to affiliates in CMHAMM Procedure format with an accompanying bulletin (signed by the DAO).

This procedure will remain in effect until the DAO formally communicates a change in the status of this procedure.
