IPLT BLOCK GRANT

PISC MEETING

UPDATE: Kim Zimmerman reviewed the information from her attendance to the Practice Improvement Steering Committee meeting on April 14. She has information on the Outcomes Project that she will share electronically upon request. Al Platt noted he is serving on the PISC ACT subcommittee; Mike Hetzman indicated he will also be joining the ACT subcommittee.

HCR WORK GROUPS: Toby announced the CEO's have decided to end the Health Care Reform work groups. The Human Resources HCR work group will share information among themselves. The clinical concerns will be directed to the IPLT. The CEO's will take on the business and financial issues along with the political matters. Toby will issue a CMHAMM Bulletin to clarify this decision.

**OVERVIEW OF
INTERAIDD:**

Mary Clissold introduced Frank Taylor, Senior Developmental Disabilities clinician at CEI. Frank gave an overview of the InterRAIDD, a standardized outcome measurement. He provided a handout of the tool to measure adult intellectual disability, which is administered by a clinician. The InterRAIDD could replace the ICAP and clinical assessment currently in use. Frank has administered it 28 times and likes it. He stated it is a two hour process for new consumers, and less than one hour for current consumers. The data entry is web-based and takes approximately 10 minutes. Current practice is assessment with annual re-assessment. A single comprehensive score is not generated; rather scores are compiled within domains. He has received notice the pilot is now complete. It is unknown if it can be incorporated into the electronic medical record.
